Reintegration & Family Services Coordinator (Juvenile Center): Full-time position available in Berrien County, Michigan
Salary: \$37,178

Required: Bachelor's Degree with a major in Social Work, Psychology, Sociology, Criminal Justice, Corrections, Counseling or related field.

Under the supervision of the Clinical and Treatment Services Manager or assigned Juvenile Center Supervisor, the Reintegration and Family Services Coordinator is responsible for the development and implementation of a comprehensive reintegration service plan for youth in out of home placements. The Reintegration and Family Services Coordinator is responsible for providing family support services as well as community supervision and counseling services for youth released from out of home placements. In addition, The Reintegration and Family Services Coordinator is responsible for supervising youth who have been ordered to electronic monitoring and Home Detention. This position is responsible for maintaining accurate case files and all required reports regarding the Reintegration and Family Services Program. This position is required to participate in Treatment Team Meetings, staffings, case reviews, Court Hearings, etc., as assigned, works weekends, holidays, evenings or flexible hours as assigned in the fulfillment of the duties of Reintegration and Family Services Coordinator. Reintegration Services are implemented based upon Council of Juvenile Correctional Administrators (CJCA) Performance Based Standards for Juvenile Correction and Detention Facilities. Duties are carried out in accordance with the Courts' statutory purpose as well as Court, County, and Juvenile Center Policies and Procedures. The Reintegration and Family Services Coordinator position is a member of the General Employees Unit of AFSCME, Council 25, Local 2757.

Desired: Knowledge and experience in family counseling, techniques and programs. Knowledge and experience in Residential Treatment / Corrections and Detention Programs. Knowledge and experience in developing and implementing effective Reintegration Programs.
