- 4. Make four copies of all attachments and this application. Take all copies to the court clerk.
- 5. Depending on local practice, the clerk of the court may set a hearing date at the time of filing. If a hearing date is set at the time of filing, the clerk of the court will complete the Notice of Hearing.
- 6. Go to the local law enforcement agency for biometric data collection. There may be a fee for this.
- 7. Mail a copy of the application packet and your biometric data to the Michigan State Police by first-class mail to Michigan State Police, Criminal Justice Information Center Criminal History, PO Box 30266, Lansing, Michigan 48909.
- 8. Mail a copy of the application packet to the Attorney General of the State of Michigan by first-class mail to Office of the Attorney General, Criminal Appellate Division, PO Box 30217, Lansing, Michigan 48909.
