COMMUNITY DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROGRAM
COST PER CASE ANALYSIS

Michigan's Community Dispute Resolution Act, 260 PA 1988, requires that the State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) annually report a variety of statistical data regarding operation of the program, including "estimated costs of hearing." In 1988, at the time the legislation was enacted, mediation was widely viewed as a process analogous to a traditional court hearing or case evaluation, pursuant to MCR 2.403. That is, upon notice given, a "hearing" would be held, a resolution reached, and paperwork disposing of the court case would be filed.

Community mediation actually followed an entirely different process model, however, and the notion of presenting evidence to a fact-finder in a traditional adversarial "hearing" does not exist. This is significant because the dispute resolution process employed at CDRP centers actually extends from the initial intake to either informal resolution by telephone or correspondence, or to a formal face-to-face meeting with possible later involvement of the mediator. While measuring only the costs of holding face-to-face meetings with the parties could be calculated, those figures would bear no meaningful relationship to the dispute resolution process employed by the centers.

In short, because "hearings" in the traditional sense of the word do not take place in the overall work of CDRP centers, SCAO instead provides a "cost per case" figure calculated by a number of methods. Each method provides a slightly different perspective on "cost per case," depending on whether just the annual CDRP grant or the center's entire application (projected) cash budget is used in the calculation. The four models shown below do not take into consideration the other services provided by the centers, such as conflict resolution training and providing assistance to courts in screening cases appropriate for mediation.

Model 1: CDRP Award by Cases Disposed. The SCAO Community Dispute Resolution Program award is divided by all cases disposed. This number reflects that there is work performed in every case opened, whether or not parties reach an agreement, or if agreements are not reached because one or more parties refuse to use the centers' services.

Model 2: Application Cash Budget by Cases Disposed. The total application cash budget (as projected in grant applications submitted to request funding) divided by all cases disposed. This number reflects not only the CDRP award, but the additional funds that are projected to be available to the center for provision of mediation service, training, and other dispute resolution services.

Model 3: CDRP Award by Core Cases. The SCAO award is divided by the number of "core cases." Core cases include mediations (face-to-face meetings), conciliations (usually telephone negotiated settlements where parties do not meet face-to-face), arbitrations, and meeting facilitations.

Model 4: Application Cash Budget by Core Cases. The total application cash budget (as projected in grant applications) divided by the number of "core cases."

Note: Cost per case generally should not be used as a single measure of a CDRP center's performance. Factors such as case type and case complexity may significantly affect cost calculations. For example, centers with higher levels of small claims cases may reflect lower cost per case figures than centers managing more complex general jurisdiction or probate cases.
