COMMUNITY MEDIATION TRAINING

Oakland Mediation Center (OMC) is now accepting applications for the next 40-Hour Community Mediation Training. The training is designed to teach participants the skills necessary to act as mediators in facilitating the resolution of general civil disputes. OMC conducts mediation on-site at the Oakland County District Courts in Pontiac, Rochester, Southfield and Waterford and at their Bloomfield Hills office.

40-Hour Community Mediation Training is scheduled:

April 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, 2014
8:30am - 5:00pm

Cost: \$100 **once approved for the Community Mediation Program*
Fee includes breakfast, lunch and refreshments

*****After completion of training, there is a service requirement of 40 half days per year, for two years. Certificates will be given when the service requirement is met.***

Applicants should have an interest in working in their community, can commit to the service requirement and have the ability to commute to one or all of the District Courts listed above.
