Center Directors:

A limited number of spaces are available in the SCAO-sponsored 44-hour domestic relations training program for centers that are not technically a part of the pilot project to provide services to unrepresented, low income mediation services to divorcing couples.

If your center currently manages divorce cases or is in discussions with courts in your service area to begin mediation in domestic relations cases, the SCAO will consider accepting applications from volunteer mediators who agree to serve as mediators in at least 12 cases over a 24 month period. To be eligible for consideration, the prospective attendee must be a currently trained general civil mediator and have at least 20 hours of experience as a mediator. The training is offered at no cost to the center or attendees; SCAO will also arrange and pay for overnight accommodations. Centers must demonstrate that they currently, or are soon to have, domestic relations matters referred to them by a trial court. Applications will be considered in the order in which they are received.

Registration and application forms are attached as both pdfs and as Word document forms that permit data to be entered directly into the form. The registration deadline is Thursday, August 26, 2010. Additional information will be sent after the registration deadline.
