Dear Court Administrators, Clerks of Court, and Probation Staff:

Subject: New Court Disposition Codes

The Criminal Records Division has implemented the use of the following Court Disposition Codes (CDC). When submitting a final court disposition electronically to the MSP, this updates the Criminal History Record completing the process of an arrest/charge incident.

MINOR IN POSSESSION (MIP) TAKEN UNDER MCL 436.1703

Code accepted for all District, Circuit, and Circuit Family Division/Probate Courts. Both CDC's are Suppressed, Non-public.

Deferred MIP- **DPM**

Dismissed-MIP- **DMM**

Non-public records are accessible only by using the specific purpose code in scan line 52 that is associated with the type of offense. Query purpose code for MIP is: 52:MIP

NEW JUVENILE COURT CODES

New Juvenile Court Codes can only be entered by using a Juvenile/Probate Originating Agency Identifier (ORI).

Public Record

WTA- Waived to Adult Court

When entering a CDC of WTA, also include the ORI of the District or Circuit Court where the case is being waived. This field is located on the EJUD screen "Circuit ORI." The allowed ORI's are either a District or Circuit Court.

TRS- Transfer to another County

When entering a CDC of TRS, also include the ORI of the Juvenile Court you are transferring the case to. This field is located on the EJUD screen "Circuit ORI." Only Juvenile/Probate ORIs are allowed.

Non-Public Record

These incidents will go to a report to be purged from Criminal History Record and Federal Bureau of Investigation.

JCC- Juvenile Consent Calendar

JDA- Juvenile Diversion Act

NAP- Not Authorized Petition

TTC- Transfer to Tribal Court
