

## Minimum Standard Data – Veterans Treatment Court

MCL 600.1210 states that each veterans treatment court shall collect and provide data on each individual applicant and participant and the entire program as required by the State Court Administrative Office. The information collected must include a minimum standard data set developed and specified by the State Court Administrative Office. In accordance with this act, the State Court Administrative Office has prepared the following minimum standard data sets. The minimum standard data sets include the minimum data that must be reported to the State Court Administrative Office on an annual basis.

Data must be collected and reported for all applicants screened for veterans treatment court, even if the applicant was not accepted into the veterans treatment court program. Therefore, the minimum standard data that follows is broken into two sets; one set for screening and one set for case management data relevant to accepted participants. This document provides descriptions and valid values for each of the variables in the minimum standard data sets. This information should be entered into the Drug Court Case Management Information System (DCCMIS).

### Set 1: Screening
