### Software Updates

There will not be a Software Release CD sent to JIS District Courts this spring. We will be applying the following updates to your software on Thursday, March 17, 2011. If your court has not applied the 2010 Fall Release, these updates will not be applied until after you have applied the 2010 Fall Release.

### Traffic/Criminal/Probation

1. **Crime Victim Rights Assessment Report** – Updated form CVR-606 from 05/01 version to 12/10 version. This update was in reference to the Serious & Specified Amount change from \$50.00 to \$75.00.

### Civil

1. **Civil Online Garnishment Update** – When an *Initial Disclosure Date* is entered, the information is updated to the Actions screen and the ROA, e.g. DCF62 - DISCLOSURE INDEBTED FILED. When a *Service Date* was later entered and a monetary amount added to the *Fee* column, the program would erroneously duplicate the DCF62 code and ROA entry. This error is fixed in the software update.

## Cash

### **1. Cash Online – Fixed two problems discovered after our 2010 Fall release.**

- a. When a case number was changed on the Cash Transaction (receipt) screen, the *Venue* field was not updating to reflect the new venue.
- b. If a receipt was rang using a combined cash code (e.g. MYOR), voided, the case number changed, and the receipt re-rang, the Statute file was incorrectly retrieving MYSF/MYFE for the re-ring.

## **Enhanced Citation (ECIT) Fix Applied by Michigan State Police**

The Enhanced Citation (ECIT) field on the Criminal History Records - EJUD and MJUD screens was added as part of the 2010 Software Release. This field allows courts to include the enhanced PACC Code, if applicable, when submitting or modifying judgment information to CHR. The *ECIT:* field is not required and is populated by the user on the EJUD or MJUD screen in the District Court System.

We were informed by Michigan State Police (MSP) on January 11, 2011 that using the *ECIT:* field on multi-count offenses was not reporting correctly to CHR. On January 12, 2011, JIS Operations sent a LEIN Administrative Message to the courts regarding use of the *ECIT:* field. The remedy was to report any count which includes the *ECIT:* as a separate EJUD or MJUD transaction and if you had already entered ECIT information on multi-count offenses, to query CHR to ensure it was posted correctly.

We were recently advised by MSP that this problem was fixed on February 9, 2011. You no longer have to submit separate entries when using the ECIT field on multi-count offenses.

**Again, there will be no CD forthcoming.
