## Release Details

The 2012/1 Software Release Schedule is given below:

February 21, 2012 - CD's sent to Pilot Courts  
March 8, 2012 - JIS installs in Online Courts after regular business hours  
**March 12, 2012 - Final version CD's sent to all other Distributed Courts**

**IMPORTANT:** Software changes are described in this announcement. Please forward or copy and distribute this to all court staff. We will not be providing a training session for the release. Please call or e-mail if you have any questions or discover any problems with the release.

## Traffic/Criminal/Probation Updates

- 1. Crime Victim Rights:** 2011 PA 294 amends MCL 780.901 and 780.905, requiring the \$75.00 crime victim assessment (*Cash Code MYCV*) on **all misdemeanor convictions** (one assessment per case) and eliminating the separate categories of serious and specified misdemeanors. This is effective for adjudications and deferrals occurring on and after April 1, 2012. The amount assessed is based on the convicted charge instead of the original charge (as it had been since January 1, 2006). The Crime Victim Rights report will be modified to address these changes and is a work in progress. JIS will apply the programming changes at a later date and send notification to you at that time.

# Next Generation- Michigan Court System (MiCS)

We are making good progress in the development of NGJIS, now known as MiCS (Michigan Court System). We are working closely with the pilot courts and are nearing the implementation for the Civil phase. The functionality needed for Criminal is being developed and testing will begin after the Civil implementation.

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- State Minimum Costs:** 2011 PA 293 amends MCL 769.1j, changing the state minimum cost to \$50.00 for **all misdemeanor convictions** (assessed per count if other assessments ordered on that count) and eliminating the separate categories of serious and specified misdemeanors. This is effective for adjudications and deferrals occurring on and after April 1, 2012. Please see **Cash Updates** on page 5 for further details on the new *Cash Code JSMD* we are recommending.
- Payable Misdemeanors:** Courts who have *Charge* codes marked as *Payable Misdemeanors* with standard assessments will need to evaluate and update those codes so the Crime Victim Assessment *Cash Code MYCV* and the new State Minimum Cost *Cash Code JSMD* (see page 5) are included.

When updating the payable misdemeanors, JIS suggests to end the current *Charge* code and re-use the same *Charge* code with the new assessments. Due to upcoming programming changes, you do not need to mark the *Crime Victim Reportable* field. See example of a new *Charge* code below:

**2012 Public Act 13 reduces the number of parking violations for a license hold from 6 to 3 effective May 16, 2012.**

**JIS will modify our program to account for this change and more information will be forthcoming.**

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#### 4. Ticket Upload

- For online courts, the Ticket Selection (**F7-TKT**) screen will only display tickets which have the ORI# of the online court doing the request. Previously, tickets with invalid and blank ORI's were also included on the screen. Now if a ticket with an invalid or blank ORI# is submitted, it will not be seen on the Ticket Selection screen by any court.
- Courts will now have the ability to add the first Multi-Count Suffix Indicator to a single count ticket. Courts interested in enabling this feature should contact JIS.
- If the police officer checks an accident type, the system will now update the Case Entry (CAS) screen. If more than one accident type is selected by the officer when he/she submits the ticket, the data transferred to the *Accident Type* field on the Case Entry (CAS) screen will be determined in the following order:

If Death is checked by the officer, the letter "D" will appear,  
If Injury is checked by the officer, the letter "I" will appear,  
If Damage to Property is checked by the officer, the letter "P" will appear.

Help Text for the *Acc Type* field on the Traffic/Criminal Case Entry (CAS) screen and the Ticket Selection Detail screen has been modified to include this information.

## Traffic/Criminal/Probation Forms Updates

*The following forms were updated to the SCAO approved version.*

### 1. Traffic/Criminal Plea By Mail (PBM) - DC223 (7/11)

Verbiage was changed on the printed form in item #1 on page one and in item #4 on page two. There are no screen changes.

### 2. Civil Infraction Judgment (CIJ) - CIA 02 (3/11)

The CIJ screen has been modified to match the revised form.

- A field for *I certify that Defendant is not in the military service, etc.* has been added. This field will be marked by the system when the charge disposition DS19 (Default Judgment) is used. The system will also mark the fields *Defendant is in Default* and *Defendant must pay* when DS19 is used.

## 1. State Minimum Costs - New Cash Code JSMD

2011 PA 293 amends MCL 769.1j, changing the state minimum cost to \$50.00 for all misdemeanors and eliminating the separate categories of serious and specified misdemeanors effective April 1, 2012. We are instructing courts to create a new *Cash Code JSMD*. An example is provided below. You will have to determine the *Screen Priority* and *Transmittal Line#* for your *Local Form*.

No changes need to be made to *Cash Code JSMO* (STATE COSTS - SIMPLE MISD/ORDINANCE VIOL) and *JSSS* (STATE COSTS - SPECIFIED/SERIOUS MISD). **Do not delete these codes.**

## Cash Reports-Forms Updates

### 1. Collections Audit Screen

The Collections Audit Screen has been updated to edit reports and stop selection outside report range. Several messages were added to describe errors in selection criteria.

### 2. Fee Transmittal for State of Michigan - Form 295 (Rev. 11-11)

Line 2 previously read "Do Not Use" and the amount column was blacked out. The Department of Treasury revised the form and memorandums were sent in Fall 2011 from SOS and JIS regarding the form changes. Courts are now required to report clearance fees using the transmittal form. The system has been modified so you can now update *Cash Code DLRF* to generate the totals for line 2. The account number reported on line 2 is 228.30. Line 6b remains unchanged with account number 228.57, which is where *Cash Code DLRJ* is reported.

**IMPORTANT:** Once the release has been applied, you must update the *Cash Code DLRF* by adding line 2 to the *Transmittal Line# State Form* column. See example below.

*When making systematic modifications to the Cash Codes Update screen, it is recommended Courts make these changes at the beginning or the end of the day when users are not performing cash transactions or updating the Disposition (DSP) screen.*

## SOS & LEIN Updates

### 1. LEIN Entries Screen

The following fields were added by JIS on December 7, 2011 and a memorandum was sent to the courts regarding this information. A brief description of the changes are given below:

- EXL or 24 - Extradition Limitations. This is a one character value in the range of 1-5 or A-E. It is a required field when EXT has YES entered.
- ADO or 95 - Additional Offense. This is a one character Y/N field used to indicate additional warrant records. NCIC only accepts one warrant for a person from a single ORI. This field has not yet been activated by LEIN.
- ETN or 100 - Ethnicity. For warrants entered where Race = White, this is an optional field used to indicate whether you can say for certain that the individual is “H” Hispanic or Latino or “N” No the person is NOT Hispanic or Latino. This field has not yet been activated by LEIN.

## Civil Updates

### 1. Civil Report Generator

The Event Clerk field on the Civil Report Generator has been modified to allow a user to leave the clerk initials blank when using a sort code of 1 - 9. This will generate a report displaying all clerks.



# Civil Forms Updates

The following forms were updated to the SCAO approved version.

## 1. Judgment Small Claims (JSC) - DC 85 (1/12)

The verbiage on the printed form was changed from 'within 21 days' to 'within 30 days' in the first sentence of Item 2. The JSC screen was also modified to reflect this change.

# Program Corrections

## 1. Traffic/Criminal Pretrial Release/Custody & Bond (PRC)

The 8x11 Pretrial Release form was changed to display the date of birth with a two character year. This was changed to correct an issue with the wrong century displaying.

## 2. Traffic/Criminal Batch Postcard Notice to Appear

The Notice to Appear postcard will now print Officer #1 first and then Officer #2 when more than one police officer is entered on the Case Entry (CAS) screen.

## 3. Traffic/Criminal Case

In some instances, the wrong description of the charge would appear in the ROA after scheduling an event using the Case Entry (CAS) screen. This problem has been fixed.

## 4. Cash Report Screen

The screen has been fixed to allow for dates greater than 2010 in the *Offense Year* field for the Payment Distribution Report.

## 5. Collections Audit Report

This report was generating an error message and has been fixed.

## 6. Cash Online

If the court only has one venue for a division (Civil or Traffic/Criminal), the cash transaction screen will default to that value when taking payments for cases not yet on the system.

## 7. Civil Garnishment

The program will no longer duplicate the Writ of Garnishment-Served entry on the Action (ACT) screen or the Register of Actions (ROA) when the *service date* field or *service fee* field is modified.

## 8. Inquiry Sign-On

When signing onto the system in Inquiry mode and viewing the ROA or the Financial ROA, the system will no longer display **F13-OutQ**. The user will no longer have the ability to press **F13-OutQ** and change a printer. Also, when using **F21-Central Name Inquiry** to view the ROA, **F13-OutQ** will no longer display.
