RE: Addition of Veterans Treatment Court Deferral Code and Software Corrections

We will be applying the following updates and corrections to your case management system software on **Wednesday, March 20, 2013:**

1. **Veterans Treatment Court Deferral Code Added** – Deferral code DF07 – DEFERRED UNDER 600.1206, VETERANS TREATMENT COURT has been added. This is meant to be used by a court which has established a Veterans Treatment Court in compliance with Public Act 335 of 2012.

The CHR Court Disposition Code (CDC) for DF07-Veterans Treatment Court has also been added to the Code Files. When accessing the Criminal History Records – EJUD screen via the EJD hop code and case number, the correct disposition code of **DPV** (Deferred-Veterans Treatment Court) will populate the *CDC* field and be sent to CHR. If the case is ultimately dismissed on the Disposition (DSP) screen with a DS08, DS25 or DS26, and you hop to the *Criminal History Records - EJUD* screen, the new CHR Disposition code of **DMV** (Dismissed-Veterans Treatment Court) will populate the *CDC* field. CHR began accepting the two new codes in late February 2013.

2. **Civil Notice To Appear** – The description of the hearing was not appearing below the HEARING check box on the Civil Notice To Appear after the Fall 2012-2 Software Release was applied. This has been corrected with the software update. **NOTE:** This fix was previously applied to the Online Courts.
3. **Cash Processing Screen** – Since the Fall 2012-2 Software Release was applied, the system is removing the payee name typed in the BOND PAYDOWN: *Name* field and replacing it with the defendant name or third party poster. This has been corrected with the software update.

4. **Crime Victim Rights Report Help Text** – Updated Help Text for the Crime Victim Rights Report will be applied. This report is available on the *Traffic/Criminal As Required Reports* screen and the *Court Wide Cash Report Screen*.

REMINDER: If a screen has Help Text available, the word **Help** appears on the bottom of the screen with the other function keys. Press **Alt + F1** to access the Help Text. If you place the cursor on a specific field or function key and press **Alt + F1**, the field description or function key Help Text is displayed. If you place the cursor someplace other than a specific field or function key, the entire Help Text for the screen is displayed for viewing and printing.
