### Abstractable Charge:

- An offense/PACC code that is associated with a SOS code.

### Abstract:

- Updates an individual's Secretary of State driving record (A or B type abstract)
- Reports alcohol and drug statistical information (B or S type abstract)
- Michigan Vehicle code MCL 257.8a states that "**Convictions must be reported to the Department of State within 5 days**".
- The exceptions to the 14 day reporting requirement are Drug Crimes and Felony Auto-Used. These are to be reported within 5 days of the sentencing date.

### Abstract processing will be initiated when a user with abstract authority:

- Enters a disposition on an abstractable charge (A type abstract)
- Enters a sentencing event (SEN, DSP, PRHD, TRF) on an abstractable charge (B or S type abstract)
- Chooses option "A" for abstract next to a case, and F6 to create

### Events:

An event is added to the Register of Actions for each abstract that is created or modified. Examples:

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## Abstract Types

A = Adjudication Abstract - Updates the Defendant's Driving Record

- All abstracts should be created within 5 days of adjudication (disposition is entered on the charge) except offenses of Drug Crimes and Felony Auto Used.

S = Sentence/Statistical Abstract - Completed at sentencing, Updates Alcohol Audit/Immobilization Statistical Report

- Sentencing judge is required.
- Circuit Court cases require a sentencing event.
- Juvenile cases will automatically create a sentence record in order to complete the abstract when a DSP or PRHD event is entered.
- Judgment results such as fines, jail, community service and alcohol programs must be completed manually when applicable.
- Vehicle forfeiture/immobilization information should be completed in the sentencing screen and will require vehicle data to be completed in the case edit screen.

B = Both - Updates the Defendant's Driving Record and the Statistical Report.

- Alcohol offenses with no A abstract, may be combined and submitted as a B "Both Adjudication and Sentencing/Statistical" type abstract.
- Sentencing judge is required.
- Drug Crimes (9200, 1140) and Felony Auto Used (1430, 1440) offenses will default to a B type abstract.
- Drug Crimes and Felony Auto Used abstracts will reflect the sentencing date in the adjudication date field.
- Judgment results such as fines, jail, community service and alcohol programs must be completed manually when applicable.
- Suspended/Restricted fields apply to drug crimes only and should be completed in the sentencing screen.
- Driving restriction/location information (for drug crimes only) must be completed manually.
