Rule 9.202 (B) Grounds for Action. A judge is subject to censure, suspension with or without pay, retirement, or removal [INSERT COMMA HERE] for conviction of a felony, physical or mental disability that prevents the performance of judicial duties, misconduct in office, persistent failure to perform judicial duties, habitual intemperance, or conduct that is clearly prejudicial to the administration of justice.
