### **Justices Are Going “On the Road” Michigan Supreme Court to Hear Oral Argument at Ann Arbor Pioneer High School**

- Who:** Michigan Supreme Court Justices  
800+ High School Students
- What:** The Michigan Supreme Court will hear oral argument in *Estate of Beals v State of Michigan*
- When:** April 29, 2015 – 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- Where:** Ann Arbor Pioneer High School, 601 W. Stadium Blvd.  
Washtenaw County high schools to attend including students from Community, Huron, Pathways, Pioneer, and Skyline high schools in Ann Arbor plus students from Dexter, Milan, Saline, True North, and Whitmore Lake high schools. A debriefing session with attorneys will follow oral argument.
- Why:** While the Supreme Court normally hears oral argument at the Michigan Hall of Justice in Lansing, Supreme Court justices and staff are traveling to various communities as part of "Court Community Connections," which the Supreme Court started in 2007 as a public education program aimed principally at high school students. The goal is to help students understand the appellate courts and Michigan's judicial system.
