- Why:** To highlight Michigan trial courts that are implementing new technology to increase efficiency and improve access. 62B uses a high-tech evidence presentation system in several innovative ways apart from trials, such as advising defendants of their rights, contacting interpreters, displaying the penalties for the offense, conduct video arraignments, and much more. In addition, the court uses other technologies, such as macros, a pink noise system to facilitate sidebar conferences, and a monitor at the entrance that displays the court schedule and notices to visitors.
