## Supreme Court Appoints Retired Wayne County Judge as Special Master in JTC Complaint Against Brennan

LANSING, MI, June 14, 2018 – The Michigan Supreme Court today appointed retired Wayne County Circuit Court Judge William J. Giovan as a special master to conduct an evidentiary hearing on the Judicial Tenure Commission's official complaint against Livingston County District Judge Theresa Brennan.
