### **The Michigan Supreme Court Will Hear the First Case of the 2017-2018 Term in the Old Supreme Court Courtroom at the Capitol on October 11; Additional Cases to be Heard at the Hall of Justice**

**What:** The Michigan Supreme Court will hear oral argument in case #150643

**When:** October 11, 2017 – 9:30 a.m.

**Where:** The [old Supreme Court courtroom](#) on the third floor of the State Capitol.

**Why:** The Court's long-standing tradition is to hear the first case of each new term in the old Supreme Court courtroom, located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the State Capitol. The other [10 cases](#) will be argued in the Supreme Court courtroom on the sixth floor of the Hall of Justice, 925 W. Ottawa Street, Lansing, beginning at approximately 11:15 a.m. and continuing on October 12.
