What: Washtenaw County Veterans Treatment Court Celebrates Second Group Graduation

Michigan has 20 veterans treatment courts—more than any other state. Veterans Treatment Courts provide treatment for veterans who are facing charges due to mental health issues or substance abuse. The Washtenaw County Veterans Treatment Court is a judicially supervised court that improves public welfare, reduces correctional costs, and also enhances community safety.

The Washtenaw County Veterans Treatment Court will celebrate its second group graduation in the Ann Arbor Justice Center. The ceremony will highlight the accomplishments of five veterans who have completed the rigorous treatment court program. The graduation ceremony will include keynote speaker Justice Bridget Mary McCormack, recognition of each individual graduate, and an after-ceremony reception.
