### THE CASE | *Carpenter v United States*

Defendant Carpenter was convicted of armed robberies based, in part, on several months of his cell phone location history. Law enforcement got these records from Carpenter's cell provider without a warrant, relying on a procedure that presumes the Fourth Amendment does not protect

information you share with someone else. **Is government tracking your whereabouts through cell phone records a search under the Fourth Amendment? Does the government need a warrant to do this?**

### Considering a Legal Career?

Learn about the legal profession like a law student. Argue a moot court case in the Michigan Supreme Court courtroom.

- Play the role of an attorney or justice.
- Meet with justices, judges, attorneys, and law students.
- Sharpen your research, writing, and public speaking skills.
