OPINION AND ORDER RE: PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO ENFORCE PERMANENT
INJUNCTION AND FOR CONTEMPT AGAINST DEFENDANT

The matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's motion to hold Defendant in contempt for violating the permanent injunction the Court entered on July 16, 2014. The order bars Defendant from making harmful or derogatory statements or postings about Plaintiff, its partners, agents, or employees. Plaintiff claims that after the injunctive order was entered, Defendant posted several derogatory statements on a social media website about Plaintiff and its employee and partner.

Plaintiff filed this motion on August 5, 2014 and served it on Defendant at his last known address. As of the date of this order, Defendant has not responded in writing to the motion and did not appear for the August 13, 2014 hearing.


As support for its claim that Defendant is violating the injunction, Plaintiff presented the Court with copies of Defendant's Internet postings as well as emails Defendant sent to Plaintiff's

counsel. Review of the postings and emails confirms that Defendant violated the permanent injunction and appears to be doing so willfully. As a sanction for violating the order, the Court orders Defendant to pay Plaintiff \$500 within 14 days. If Defendant fails to pay as ordered or continues to violate the injunction, the Court will consider further sanctions including fines or jail time under MCL 600.1715.
