Clarifying/identifying 'presumptive heirs' is a great idea - good luck! (We aren't aware of any statutory definition.)

One suggestion would be for the form item which asks for identification of interested persons to include 'check all that apply'. Another idea is to add a check box for siblings, as they can often be presumptive heirs on adult conservatorships where there is no spouse or children and parents are deceased. And a last suggestion would be to use Testimony Regarding Heirs (if modified to that title) in all probate files to determine interested persons.
