Memorandum

The Michigan State Council for Interstate Juvenile Supervision has chartered a brief survey to evaluate awareness of the Interstate Compact for Juveniles (ICJ) in Michigan. The ICJ is a compact applicable to all 50 states formed under the authority of federal law that governs the transfer of supervision of juveniles on parole or probation, travel of juveniles across state lines, and the return of juveniles who have run away, escaped or absconded. Nationally, the compact is administered by the Interstate Commission for Juveniles formed by one representative (commissioner) from each state. In Michigan, the state council includes representatives from the executive, judicial and legislative branches as well as the ICJ office within MDHHS.
