JC 89, Order Transferring Petition to Consent Calendar

Most recent update: (9/16) version

Use of existing stock: Existing stock cannot be used.

The form was redesigned to be used before authorization and after authorization as contemplated by MCL 712A.2f(3) and (10). The title of the form was changed to accurately reflect the form's usage. An ex parte checkbox was placed in the title of the form to indicate when the order is issued ex parte.

Item 3 was revised to use the language of MCL 712A.2f(1) instead of the language of the court rule. Item 4 was revised to use the language of MCL 712A.2f(2). Item 5 was revised to use the language of MCL 712A.2f(7). The sentence "This is not adjudication of guilt or innocence." was added to clarify that the court is not making a finding that the juvenile is guilty or innocent when transferring to the consent calendar. Item 7 was revised to use the language of MCL 712A.2f(7). The notes at the bottom of the form were removed.
