40-Hour General Civil Mediator Training: This 40-hour State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) approved training is designed to teach participants the skills necessary to act as mediators in facilitating the resolution of general civil disputes. Participants will receive a detailed mediation manual and a jump-drive containing reproducible mediation forms.

40-Hour Domestic Relations Mediation Training: This 40-hour State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) approved training is designed to teach participants the skills necessary to act as mediators in facilitating the resolution of divorce and custody issues and includes the SCAO required 8-Hour Domestic Violence Screening Training for Mediators. Participants will receive a detailed mediation manual and a jump-drive containing reproducible mediation forms.

8-Hour Advanced Mediation Training: Both novice and experienced mediators recognize that every case brings new challenges.
