Release Highlights

- CHR extract program will now pick up dispositions under a Delay of Sentence and report it with sentencing remarks indicating "Sentence Delayed". **PLEASE** run your Case Review List for Deferred Cases **BEFORE** the December 2008 Release is applied. Also, due to this change, the release **MUST** be applied prior to Jan 1, 2009.
- Case Type changes will be effective Jan 1, 2009.

Criminal Case Header

- A Social Security number field has been added to the Criminal Case Header screen and if the number is supplied by the prosecutor via the Prosecutor Interface, it will automatically be brought in.

Register of Actions

- An Adjusted column has been added in the Assessments area of the ROA display and print. This column will display or print any adjustment amounts so that it will reflect a true adjustment and not a payment. For example: When a balance is adjusted through the RS screen due to a codefendant making a payment on restitution, the amount will show in the adjusted column rather than in the payment column. Negative assessments are also adjustments. Payment adjustments made on the RS screen and negative assessments made on the Court screen are included in the adjustments column.
- The amounts in the paid column will now display and print with a negative sign after the amount.

Disposition Codes

- DPG (Drug Court Plead Guilty) result code has been added for courts that have a Drug Court Plan in place. The DPG disposition is NOT sent to CHR.

CHR

- The CHR extract has been changed to pick up dispositions under a Delay of Sentence and report them with sentencing remarks indicating "Sentence Delayed". Previously, these dispositions were not reported until a dismissal or a violation was entered, therefore an increase in EJUD transactions is expected. However, due to the fact that some of these Delays may be old, **we strongly recommend that each court run the Case Review List for Deferred Cases BEFORE THE RELEASE IS APPLIED** and review the cases under DLS for accuracy and correct those cases that are inaccurate.
- If a court uses the DPG result code and DLS, the disposition will not be sent to CHR until it is dismissed or re-sentenced.

Forms

The following forms have been added to the system and are only available in AFP format:

- MC 09 Dismissal. The hop code is DSM
- MC 238 Judgment After Bond Forfeiture. The hop code is JBF
- * CC 385 Order on Motion to Modify, Extend, or Terminate Personal Protection Order. The hop code is MET

Revisions have been made to the following forms:

- MC 26 Notice of Intent to Dismiss for No Progress
- MC 218 Order Revoking Release and Forfeiting Bond
- MC 219 Judgment of Sentence/Commitment to Jail
- CC 219b Judgment of Sentence/Commitment to Prison

- MC 234 Order for Counseling and Testing for Disease/Infection
- MC 274 Order for Mediation
- MC 288 Order to Remit Prisoner Funds
- MC 290 Satisfaction of Financial Obligation
- CC 236 Order Committing Juvenile to DHS (Hop Code changed)
- CC 382a Order after Hearing on Show Cause for Violating Valid Personal/Foreign Protection Order
- CC 384 Order after Hearing on Violation of Personal Protection Order

For the Order to Remit Prisoner Funds MC 288 and the Satisfaction of Financial Obligation MC 290 screens, the address for the Michigan Department of Corrections Regional Business Office has been added, per MDOC's request. An option to print a copy for the MDOC Business Office has also been added to these screens. The copy for the business office should normally be generated whether the defendant is going to prison or is already lodged in prison. If this copy is not needed, set this option to "N".

Reports

- Outstanding Receivables Report – to prevent negative numbers on the Outstanding Receivables Report, it is no longer allowed to delete Court screen events of SEN, MNY, APO, or PSN where payments have been made against assessments if the amount paid is greater than the new amount ordered.
- Case Load Report – the system now allows the court to report Part 4 of the Caseload Report quarterly to CRS via the file upload. Parts 1 and 2 have always been available for upload.

Case Type Changes

- As of January 1, 2009, the following case types are obsolete: TC, TI, TM, TO, TP, TS, TU, TZ, UC, and UO.
- As of January 1, 2009, the following case types may still be used but will no longer be counted on the Caseload Report: UF, UI, UM, UN, UT, and UW.
- As of January 1, 2009, transfer cases should be omitted from Caseload reporting by checking the Caseload Omit flag on the Case Header screen with a "Y". Since the transfer case types are obsolete, they should be filed using the following codes: DC, UT, DM, DO, DP, DS, DZ, and UF. For example, when a transfer case that would be considered a TM case type prior to 1/1/09 is filed, it will be filed as a DM case type effective 1/1/09 and flagged as "Caseload Omit".
